

Mochitsuki 2008 Community Stage Information

Sunday, January 27, 2008

The following information is to help you prepare for your group's performance on the Community Stage.

To control the traffic of all performing groups, we will make use of the outer sidewalks near the doors to the Community Stage. Please have assistance for your group readily available to help children and others with jackets and shoes before and after their performance. Please make sure your performers are properly dressed for the weather.

- 1) Your group should arrive at the *Check-in Table* at least *20 minutes prior to your scheduled performance time. This will allow you time to prepare for your performance as needed. Your group will be assigned a *Prep Area* to get ready as well as to keep your belongings. We will have volunteers to watch your belongings while your group is performing. (*If your group consists of young children, arriving 15 minutes prior to your scheduled performance will be sufficient. Please allow extra time for costume changes if needed).
- 2) Have jackets and shoes, preferably slip-ons, for the walk to the *Performance Line-up Waiting Area*.
- 3) Your group will need to be ready 10 minutes prior to your scheduled performance to proceed to the Community Stage. There will be volunteers to help direct you.
- 4) If you have a CD or a tape to play, please give it to the person at the *Check-in Table* when you sign in and fill out the instruction sheet. The audio person needs to know the track numbers and whether you are talking between the songs. If you have more than one CD/tape, clearly mark them so that they are in the order they will need to be played. Also, please label your CD/tape with your name. Your time slot includes transition time. Please keep within the time allotted for your group's performance.
- 5) Please study the map on the back so you are familiar with the layout.

The Community Stage is approximately 10.5' deep x 25' long with a ramp on the right side of the stage. The concrete stage floor will be covered with corrugated board for padding.
